14.3.1 Standardization of Plaid Pattern Repeats (example of typical title and section number of item being balloted.)

Following is a description of the typical items being balloted:

Woven plaid fabrics will be limited in repeat length offerings to 0.25 inch increments. For example, an acceptable range of repeat lengths for 10 plaid fabrics could be: 12.0”, 12.25”, 12.5”, 12.75”, 13”, 13.25”, 13.5”, 13.75”, 14.0”, and 14.5”. The tolerances for roll to roll and within roll pattern repeat measurement are unchanged (see 14.2.1).
