



AHFA Solution Partners Education Merit-Based Scholarships

Beginning in 2019, AHFA Solution Partners Education Program will offer four merit-based scholarships. The Fund is designed to benefit the children of employees working full-time at AHFA member companies, including its subsidiaries, the International Casual Furnishings Association and the Solution Partners division.

The Fund awards scholarships to students age 21 or under who are enrolled in or planning to enroll in a two-year or four-year college, university or approved vocational/technical school. Recipients must be full-time students.

Merit scholarships are \$2,500 for one year of full-time study. Recipients may re-apply in subsequent years for additional scholarships. Awards are granted for study leading to a first undergraduate degree only. Any field of study will qualify.

The merit education scholarship is administered without regard to race, creed, sex or national origin.

WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

The applicant must be a dependent child of an individual working full-time at a company that is a member of the American Home Furnishings Alliance or its subsidiaries. A dependent child is defined as one who qualifies as a dependent on the employee's federal tax return for the year in which the scholarship award is to be made.

The employee must have at least one year of continuous employment with the member company before a dependent child is eligible. Further, the employee must be working for the same member company on the date of the scholarship application and the date of the scholarship award.

Applicants for the merit scholarship may be in their senior year of high school at the time of the application. Also, students age 21 or under already in college or a vocational/technical school may apply, unless the student is in the final year of his/her post-secondary studies at the time of the application.

HOW ARE MERIT SCHOLARSHIP AWARD RECIPIENTS SELECTED?

Awards are made based on academic performance. Financial assistance is not considered in this selection.

The merit scholarship evaluation includes the following for a total of 100 points:

- GPA (50 points)
- Essay (25 points)
- Involvement/Leadership/Volunteerism (25 points)

Each application is completely confidential and is reviewed initially by the American Home Furnishings Alliance, which is the Fund administrator, and subsequently by a selection committee appointed by the Solution Partners Board of Directors.

The Solution Partners Education Fund reserves the right to discontinue the scholarship during the course of the academic year if the student's efforts, achievements or conduct is unsatisfactory.

In most cases, recipients will be notified of their award in April of the year the award is effective.

Non-recipients will also be notified in April. Applicants who are selected, as well as those who are not selected, are eligible to re-apply for a Solution Partners Scholarship in subsequent years.

HOW MANY MERIT AWARDS ARE MADE EACH YEAR?

A total of four awards are made.

HOW ARE THE AWARDS DISTRIBUTED?

Awards made on behalf of the Solution Partners Education Fund are issued in two equal installments in July and December of the year in which the award is granted. Checks are made payable directly to the educational institution.

Awards may be used to pay for tuition, books, lab fees, room and board or other educational expenses.

WHAT ARE THE RECIPIENT'S RESPONSIBILITIES?

The recipient is solely responsible for making arrangements with and fulfilling the requirements for admission to the educational institution of the student's choice. The recipient must enter a post-secondary educational institution no later than the fall term following selection for the scholarship.

Except as described in the application procedure for Solution Partners Education Fund, no obligation of any kind will be imposed upon a scholarship holder or assumed by the American Home Furnishings Alliance, its Divisions or the Solution Partners Education Fund, in connection with the granting of the scholarship.

APPLICATION PROCEEDURE

Applications for the scholarship may be made in the senior year of high school, or any year after completion of secondary school, (unless the applicant is in the final year of the program, or over age 21 at the time of application). Eligible students who wish to apply for the scholarship should submit all of the following:

- Completed Student Application
- Current Official Transcripts
- Parent Employment Verification Letter
- A list of school and non-school related clubs and organizations
- A list of honors and awards
- A list of volunteer activities
- Letter of Recommendation
- Essay

APPLICATION DEADLINE

Complete application materials must be postmarked **by midnight** on January 31 and delivered to:

Because applications will be evaluated on the information supplied, it is important that every question be answered as completely as possible.
